This year we have spent our budget on:

- Employing additional staff to reduce class sizes for mathematics in Year 5/ Year 6 and to facilitate guided groups.
- One to one tuition
- Employing a teacher for 3 days in KS1 to facilitate intervention in phonics, reading and writing
- An extra 3 days NNEB support in Early Years to facilitate intervention in reading and writing
- Additional support staff hours to ensure all children are heard read everyday
- Music support to deliver instrument tuition
- Employing a dance teacher
- Additional Parent Support Worker hours
- Consumables for Breakfast Club and Homework Club
- Subsidising the cost of educational visits/visitors
- Private tutor to deliver Literacy/Numeracy intervention
- Facilitating Street Games Activities during school holidays
- 20 Kindles to support reluctant readers
- Rising Stars reading scheme to support reluctant low level readers
